- Each goal should also serve the components of the early childhood system.
- New this year- MAX of 15% of 32p allocation for local childhood programming
- > FY24 Allocations
 - o \$504,804
 - \$249,872-Home Visiting Expansion Grant (32p4)
 - Baby Scholars
 - Bright Beginnings
 - Early Head Start
- New this year- \$162,144 just for literacy efforts from birth to 5
 - Must prioritize enrollment of those families with the highest levels of economic need
